From the Desk of

**Pastor Mark Walters**

*The one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep! See, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed. He is able to open the scroll and its seven seals."*

**Revelation 5:5**

March has often been described as the month that "comes in like a lion and goes out like a lamb." In other words, March weather can start out feeling not a whole lot different than January or February. But by the end of the month, there's a sense of spring in the air. Like a lot of weather proverbs, there's general level of truth to that statement. But anyone who's lived in Wisconsin for any length of time knows that there are seasons when the lion of March can take a bigger bite out of you at the end of the month than at the beginning. At the end of the day, weather is simply unpredictable.

The Bible speaks of another Lion who is true and sure and constant and reliable. The aged apostle John calls him, "The Lion of the tribe of Judah." This goes back to an Old Testament reference to Jesus. But why call Jesus a Lion? Because lions are the king of the jungle. Jesus is the King of the universe. As the Son of God, Jesus sits on the throne of power and majesty along with the Father and the Holy Spirit. He is the One who is holy and perfect and righteous and he has the same expectations for everything that his powerful hand has created. At the top of the list are his human creatures – you and me. Except what animal describes us? We think we're lions, we think we're large and in charge but the truth is our sins make us like a summer mosquito – pesky and annoying and deserving of only a divine handclap that will crush us in an instant. The law of the Lion roars. We melt in fear.

But this Lion is different. This Lion isn't merely about ruling the universe with his power but saving it through his blood. The Lion walked around our jungle of heartache and pain and rebellion and sin. And then the Lion did something remarkable. He changed himself into a Lamb. The predator became a predatoree. Jesus allowed sinful people to slaughter him on a cross in a manner that even lambs inside a slaughter house wouldn't be treated. The Lamb of God took all of humanity's sins upon himself. The Lamb of God allowed himself to die the death that we all deserved. And when it was all completed, the Lamb bleated triumphantly, "It is Finished." Total forgiveness had been won. The Lamb of God truly took away the sin of the world.

March is usually the month of Lent. The Lenten season is a time for each of us to focus our attention even more on the Lion who became a Lamb. My prayer is that we use this time to not only attend worship regularly but to also get alone by ourselves and to read various passages of Scripture that recalibrate our attention on what really matters – forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation. If you want a good place to start try Isaiah 53. Read just a few verses a day and meditate and marvel at the Lion who is your Lamb.

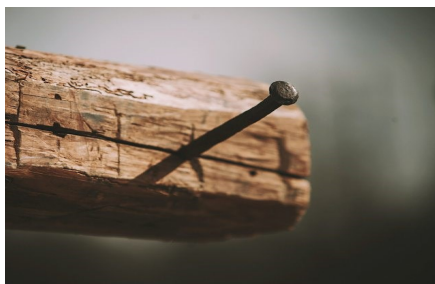

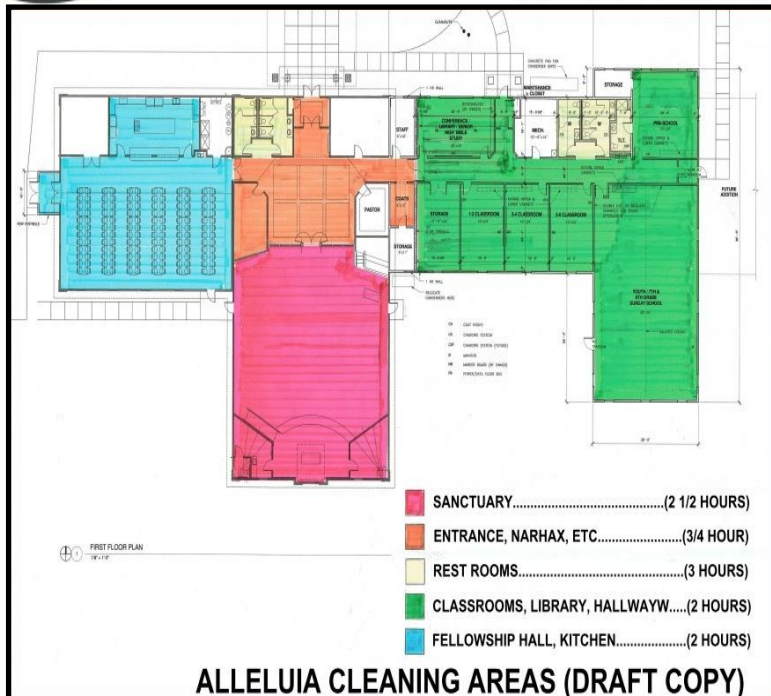

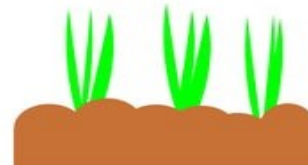
